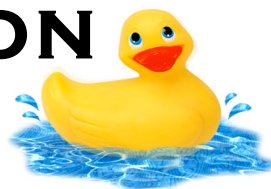

Duck Pluck Activity Information

Basic Activity Operation:

- “Ticket Booths” will be set up for families to purchase ‘play tickets’. The average price per tickets is about \$.50 with the price going down with the purchase of a larger quantity of tickets.
- The ‘play price’ for your activity will be determined by the activities committee depending on the difficulty/duration of you activity.
- ‘win tickets’ are awarded for winning keeping the win ratio at roughly 1:1
- Give a piece of candy to those that don’t win as a ‘thanks for playing’(this will be provided)
- Win tickets are redeemed at the prize area

Prior to the Event:

- Gather any tables or chairs needed for activity
- Create sign(s) for your activity detailing the number of tickets to play, win opportunities, and guidelines (if needed)
- Organize supplies needed for your activity including all chairs, table coverings, decorations, tape, and anything needed for the activity itself, noise makers for the win and a colorful and attractive sign to hang on the shade structure (other than water, electricity, or shade structure if requested)
- Please Note: If you would like helium balloons to decorate your area, we are working with Balloons by Carolyn. Therefore, we ask that you do not bring in balloons from an outside vendor or store. Thank you!
- Organize volunteers

The Day of the Event:

- **CHECK-IN** first before unloading
- Sign-In begins at **8:00am**: Please plan to have your area ready for customers by **10:00am**
- At the “Check-In/Out” booth you’ll be given:
 - Location of your activity
 - Map of where vendors unload and park
 - 2 parking passes for the designated vendor parking
 - Map of event
 - “Activity Kit” which includes: ‘win tickets’, 2 “carnie” aprons for volunteers to wear (for “play” and “win” tickets) ticket collection container, checklist of items to return, win ticket and candy vouchers, and consolation candy
- After unloading please park in the back parking lot on Del Paso Road
- As children participate in your activity you will save the ‘play tickets’
- Tear Down and Clean Up Activity area
- Check Out : place all ‘play tickets’ in the ticket collection container that will be handed in at the end of the event to the “Check In/Out” booth. Soon after the event, the Duck Pluck committee will count your ‘play tickets’ to determine your profit.
